For three decades, Mrs Ginn has been a much-loved and valued member of our school community, dedicating so much of her time, care and kindness to our pupils.

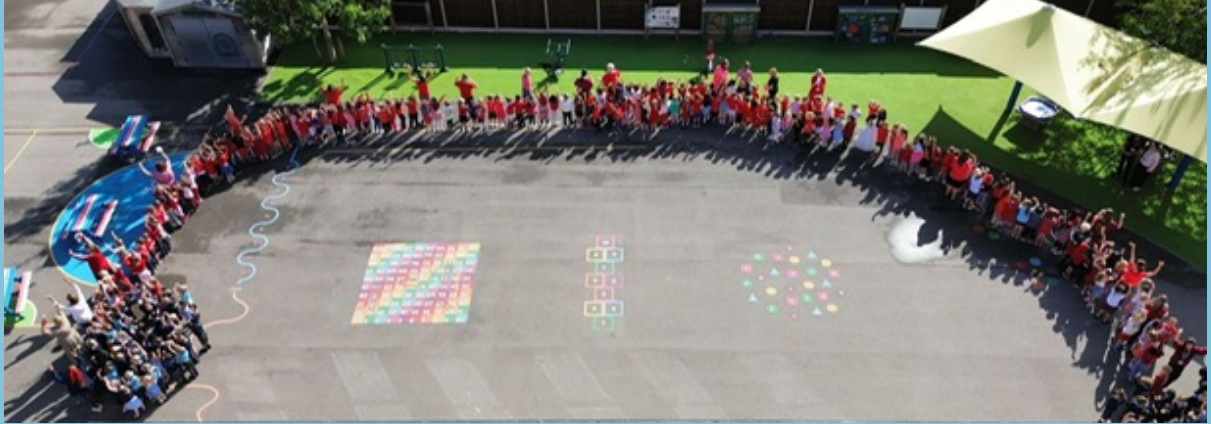
We are truly grateful for everything she has given to the school and for the positive difference she has made to so many children and families over the years.

Attendance

Absence must be reported before 9:00am – via the absence line 01932 343260 option 1

- Please do not report absences via email, as these may not be immediately picked up
- Please leave a clear message, stating full name of child, child's class, reason for being absent (i.e. vomiting/diarrhoea/cold/cough/temp)
- A call must be made each day your child is absent before 09:00am

Please note that for vomiting and diarrhoea – your child should not return to school until 48 hours from their last episode.

It is important for your child's academic and social development for them to attend school everyday.

We have 3 attendance bears named 'MAC' that are awarded to the class in each year with the best attendance every week.

Working Together to Improve Attendance

First Offence	The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time absence or irregular attendance the amount payable will be: £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days
Second Offence (within 3 years)	The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for term time absence or irregular attendance the amount payable will be: £160 per parent, per child if paid within 28 days
Third Offence (within 3 years)	The third time an offence is committed for term time absence or irregular attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates' Court

If you take your child out of school without approval for 5 or more days (which do not have to be consecutive) then the following will apply as outlined in the chart.

Penalty Notice fines will be considered when there are 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period.
